

## **Lady Braves Tie Bethel 1-1 in Rain Delayed Match**

**OTTAWA, Kan.** - The Lady Braves played Southwestern College Lady Moundbuilders to a 1-1 tie on Wednesday night at Peoples Bank Field. The overtime did not get played because of the severe weather that rolled through the area at the end of regulation.

Both teams played to a 0-0 half time score after the first 45 minutes of play. Ottawa had a few chances to take a 1-0 lead but could not capitalize as the Lady Braves out shot Southwestern 11-4 in the first period. Playing in her final home regular season game senior Stephanie Henderson started in goal for OU and had two saves in the first period.

The Lady Moundbuilders struck first in the second period just 15 minutes in when Stacy Harkness scored off of a long pass from Kayla Summers. That is where the score would stay until there was 42 seconds remaining in regulation. Sam Cooke kicked a ball from 20 yards out and it went off of a couple of SC and OU players. Whitney Bowen was in the right place at the right time and she took the rebound and put it through the net for her 18<sup>th</sup> goal of the year to give OU the 1-1 tie.

Shannon Fisher started in the second period against the Lady Moundbuilders, she had one save. Henderson moved to the field as a defender in the second period. OU out shot SC 18-11 for the game and Southwestern led in the foul count 12-2.
