Journalism Scholarship Interview Information

<i>Scholarship Awards</i>	Scholarship awards are competitive and will vary in award amounts.
<i>Requirements</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students are expected to have a portfolio ready for review by the Scholarship Committee.2. Students should also be prepared to answer questions based on the information submitted on the application and portfolio work.3. Interview attire, typically business/casual, is expected.
<i>Interview Date</i>	Interviews will occur on the Communication Visitation Day, March 9, 2007. If a student is not able to attend, special arrangements may be made. All interviews must be completed before March 9, 2007. All scholarship award decisions will be made after March 9, 2007.
<i>Interview Place</i>	Administration Building, Room 306; Ottawa University, Ottawa, KS.
<i>Interview Time</i>	Interviews begin at 1:00 PM. Individual times should be scheduled prior to the interview day.
<i>Portfolio Contents</i>	The submitted portfolio should contain samples of the student's journalistic writings. Sample news articles will be prioritized, but other journalistic writing samples, layouts, graphic arts and photographs will be considered for scholarship awards. Breadth in experience in media is a bonus.
<i>Other Activities</i>	The Communication Visitation Day will include information sessions, panels, lunch, campus tours, and some free time for student game room, book store, or appointments in other academic areas (limited appointment times available).
<i>Procedure</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students should secure an interview time for either date, by phone or email, at least one week prior to interview.2. Walk-ins will be welcome only if there is space available.3. Return application form at time of the interview.4. Individual interview times will be posted outside the designated room.5. Upon entering the room, application form and portfolio will be given to the Chair of the Scholarship Review Committee, and students should be ready to answer interview questions.
