USING AUDIO/VIDEO FEEDBACK IN BLACKBOARD

Blackboard has a recording feature for providing audio or video feedback to students on assessments such as assignments, graded discussions, or wikis and blogs. This tool is available in both the Original (undergraduate) and Ultra (graduate) experience of Blackboard's gradebook.

Recordings can help you connect with students and allow you to share useful, actionable, and more personal feedback regarding student work. Recordings are limited to five minutes in length.

Students can access the recording with the grade details and any text feedback you left for them in the Grades menu in Blackboard. The recording streams directly from their browser. They cannot download or save recordings.

Note: No captioning capability is offered for this feature which renders audio/video feedback inacccessible for some students. It is best to tell your students that you will be using audio/video feedback to give them the opportunity to tell you if this will not work for them.
